SIC ANNUAL GOALS

Below are a few goals of the SIC that pertain to our 5-Year Improvement Plan and from general needs garnered from a community survey.

- 1) Improve stakeholder communication and increase information going to families regarding academic instruction and learning opportunities.
- Increase student achievement in mathematics as measured on MAP Growth Reports and (eventually demonstrated on) SC Ready Math.
- 3) Increase community engagement through virtual and face-to-face methods throughout the school year.

- > Mt. Gallant students outpaced the state and district in academic achievement on SCReady Math and ELA, in addition to SCPASS Science.
- SCReady ELA- 59.3% Scoring Meets or Exceeds.
- > SCReady Math- 58.6% Scoring Meets or Exceeds.
- > SCPASS Science- 62.1% Scoring Meets or Exceeds.
- Selected Mt. Gallant student artwork was chosen for a special art exhibit at the Museum of York County.
- MGES Bucket Drummers and Chorus were invited to perform at Come See Me and Earth Day Birthday events.
- Finished 3rd in the district for Battle of the Books.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The closure of three elementary schools in the district led to a significant change in the student population and in the teachers in classrooms at Mt. Gallant Elementary.

Half of our student population was new to our school. We received nearly 250 new students from India Hook, Old Pointe, and other elementary schools in the district.

We also welcomed 11 new staff members to the building, including a new principal. We worked hard to develop a sense of family/community among our staff, despite limitations due to COVID protocols.
