## Mission Statement


Oakdale STEAM Elementary School will ensure that ALL students are empowered to think critically, collaborate, and become lifelong learners in a positive learning environment.



# What is Title I?



- Title I provides federal funding to schools to help students who are low achieving or at most risk of falling behind.
- Title I funding is allocated to schools based high concentrations of poverty.
- Schools with a percentage of at least 40% are eligible for a schoolwide program.



# School-wide Title I Program

A Schoolwide program means:

- We are required to complete an annual Comprehensive Needs Assessment or CNA
- Title I funds are used to support our entire educational program.
- Title I funds are used to serve ALL students in order to raise academic achievement and student growth.
- Title I funds are used to provide additional assistance to all students having difficulty reaching the state's academic performance targets.
- Schools receiving "school-wide" funding are required to track student achievement data and continuously develop/enhance the Title I plan.

# Title I Positions at Oakdale

## •Early Literacy Teacher, Mrs. Andrea Allen

- Provide short-term, individualized early intervention to help first grade children in developing effective strategies for reading and writing and to reach average levels of classroom performance.
- Provide small group instruction in reading to identified students in grades K-3.

## •Full-Time K-2 Math Interventionist, Mrs. Tracy Fisher

- Provide small group math instruction to students in K-3 to strengthen math foundational skills.

# Title I Positions at Oakdale

## • Full-Time Math Coach/Math Interventionist, Mrs. Rone Washington

- Provide model lessons and professional development using achievement data for our teachers and staff to develop and sustain high quality teaching and learning.
- Provide math intervention to 4th and 5th grade students scoring below the 25th percentile on district/state assessments.

## • Part-Time Early Intervention Tutors

- Mrs. Melissa Lyon - Provide 1:1 or small group early literacy intervention to students in K-2.
- Mrs. Rhonda Nichols - Provide 1:1 or small group early literacy and math intervention to students in K-2.
