#### WHAT IS TITLE I?

The purpose of Title I is to improve teaching and learning in high-poverty schools and to help children failing or most at-risk of failing meet challenging state academic standards.


- providing an enriched and accelerated educational program
- promoting school-wide improvement through additional services that increase the amount and quality of instructional time;
- upgrading instruction by providing staff with opportunities for professional development
- providing parents meaningful opportunities to participate in the education of their children through home-school connections



#### HOW DO WE QUALIFY FOR TITLE I FUNDS?

Title I schools within the district are selected based on information from the 135th Day Count. A poverty index for all of the schools in the district is determined and the schools are ranked from highest to lowest poverty index. Sunset Park currently has a poverty index of 75%.








## WHO BENEFITS FROM TITLE IF FUNDING?
