I am excited and eager to bring my skills as an educational leader to Richmond Drive Elementary and work with you and the staff as a partner in education to ensure our children's success.

Back to School Fair will be **Wednesday, August 15th** at Richmond Drive. Please come and meet your child's teacher and enjoy other activities. You can tour the building, find out information about programs, complete online registration, bring proof of residency and get free school supplies and books (as long as supplies last). We will have activities throughout the school and if you get hungry, we'll have food and drinks in the cafeteria. This event is sponsored by the Rock Hill School District, Westminster Presbyterian Church, Rock Hill Bible Fellowship and many other organizatoins. We want every family in our school to have a great start to the year. (Computers will be available to complete online registrations, lunch applications and volunteer screening forms. All parent volunteers must complete a new application form every two years.)

Mobile Computing Guide Parent Orientations—For parents of students in 3rd, 4th and 5th grades, you can go to <u>https://rockhill.instructure.com/courses/1082</u> to view the Mobile Computing Guide Parent Orientation and download the form that needs to be signed so your child can receive a district device. The fee is \$35 this year and there is scholarship information at the site above. All parents have to do a parent orientation every year.

Communication Methods—We want our parents to stay up to date through all the best methods of communication available. Here is how you can know what is happening:

1. Weekly E-Newsletter—A weekly e-newsletter is sent each week to update families on the happenings at Richmond Drive. Please enter your most current email address(es) on online registration so we can send it to you. Also, you can find it posted on our Facebook page and website and subscribe to it there.

- 2. **District App**—You can download our school district app on your phone and select to receive information from RDES (and other schools, too.)
- 3. **Facebook**—Like us at Richmond Drive Elementary School.
- 4. Twitter—You can link to us @richmonddrive.
- 5. Website—You can find us at <u>www.rd.rock-hill.k12.sc.us</u>.
- 6. Wednesday Communication Folder—A red folder with info comes home every Wednesday.

Arrival and Dismissal—Please follow these procedures to ensure the safety and security of your child.

- 1. Arrival—Students can be dropped off in any of the three traffic loops in the front or back of the building. A staff member will be on duty in the rear drop off area from 7:25-7:40 AM. Please do not use the faculty parking lot for drop-off of students. All students should be at school by 7:40. At 7:45, students are late and need to be signed in at the office.
- 2. **Dismissal**—Students are dismissed at 2:25 PM. All students should be picked up by 2:45 PM.
 - a. Car Riders--All parents of car-riders will go through the traffic loop from McDow Street or the loop from Richmond Drive (by the swings). Place your Richmond Drive Pick-Up Card in your windshield or show it to the person calling the children. Please do not walk up to the school to get your child. This helps ensure we get the right child going home with the right person. Anyone picking up your child by car will be required to have a Richmond Drive Pick-Up Card with the child/ren's name(s) and grade level(s) on it that should be put in the dashboard. Anyone not having the card will be asked to pull over and verify with the office that they can pick up your child.
 - b. **Bus and Van Riders**—Will be picked up in front of the school. Bus transportation can only be provided to those students living more than 1.5 miles from school.
 - c. Walkers and Bike Riders—Will be escorted by staff members down Richmond Drive and McDow Street. Kindergarten and First Graders must be escorted home by a parent/guardian, older sibling or other person approved by parents. Adults receiving K and 1st grade walkers need to have a Walker Pass that can be gotten from the office.
 - d. **Teacher Notification--**For all students, please inform your child's teacher on the first day how they will be going home. (Will they be a car rider, a bus rider, a daycare van rider, a back door walker, a front door walker, or a student in our Challenger after-school program?)
 - e. Early Dismissals--Students will not be dismissed after 2:00 PM unless there is written authorization from a doctor. Except for emergency situations, changes in the way a child goes home will not be made after 2:00 PM.
 - f. **Dismissal Changes--**If a child is going home in a different a way from "normal," a handwritten note needs to be sent to the teacher at the beginning of the day. (Please do not send emails. They may not be seen until the end of the school day.)
 - g. Photo ID—All visitors to the school will be asked for a photo ID.

Breakfast / Lunch Please also remember that all new students (all kindergarten and new students in upper grades) will need to bring their lunch or pay for their lunch until applications can be processed. There will not be any breakfast served on the first day. Student meals will be \$2.20 for lunch and \$1.10 for breakfast this year. Lunch applications can now be processed online at <u>www.schoollunchapp.com</u>.

Ice Cream Sales Ice cream items will cost .75 this year and will be sold on Friday.

Handbook The RDES Handbook is on the school website but if you'd like a paper copy, just let the office know. Please be sure to read it so you can be familiar with our policies and procedures.
