We expect our students participating in any dress down day to abide by the following guidelines:

- 1. A shirt/blouse/top should be worn with an appropriate undergarment. All clothing should be free of offensive or suggestive messages/ language and pictures. Examples of prohibited clothing items would include advertising for drugs/alcohol/tobacco products or promotion of violence. Sleeveless t-shirts are also not permitted.
- 2. Tank tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, strapless garments, see-through clothing, and low-cut tops will **NOT** be permitted. A student's shoulders must be covered by their clothing.
- 3. Skirts and shorts should be not shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
- 4. No ripped or torn clothing will be allowed. No leggings will be allowed unless worn under a skirt.
- 5. Shoes must be in compliance with the standard code of dress policy. (Therefore, no flip flops, mismatched, shower, bedroom style, spiked heels, heels higher than 2 inches may be worn.)
