Jamie Nichols Alumni Scholarship Fund

Deadline: April 3, 2020

Amount: \$1,200

Criteria: Financial need, minimum 2.9 GPA or top 50% of class, minimum 1000 SAT or 21 ACT and have a parent/guardian who has been incarcerated for longer than 12 months post-2005. **This scholarship was not claimed last year.
