The criteria for scholarships is determined by the organization sponsoring the scholarship. It is recommended that students do scholarship searches on their own if they do not meet the criteria for the scholarships listed in this newsletter. Unless specified, Northwestern High School does not sponsor or endow any of the scholarships listed in this newsletter, nor is it a part of the committees designated to determine scholarship recipients.

NAFEPA Scholarship Program

Amount: \$2,500

This scholarship is sponsored by the National Association of Federal Education Program Administrators (NAFEPA). Its purpose is to financially support postsecondary education for qualifying high school seniors attending their first year of college. Two scholarships are for students pursuing degrees in Education and the other two are for students in another field. **See Ms. Elmore for an application.**

James F. Byrnes Scholarship*

Amount: \$4,500 (renewable for four years)

This scholarship is sponsored by the James F. Byrnes Foundation. It was established in 1949 to assist young South Carolinians who had lost one or both parents to obtain a college education. Criteria: one or both parents deceased, South Carolina resident, U.S. citizen, plan to pursue a bachelor's degree at an accredited 4 year college/university, satisfactory academic record, demonstrate excellence in character and have financial need. ArrowPointe Federal Credit Union

Amount: \$500 (ten scholarships will be awarded)

This scholarship is sponsored by ArrowPointe Federal Credit Union. Criteria: Graduate from a high school in one of the following areas: (York County, Lancaster County, Great Falls or Lewisville), have an active ArrowPointe FCU account in good standing for at least 90 days prior to the application deadline and enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester at their postsecondary institution. Amount: \$1,000

Amount: Not specified

This scholarship is in memory of James "Peanut" Douglas in honor of all he did to improve the quality of life for those in his community. **Criteria:** Be a graduating, minority senior from Rock Hill School District, unweighted 3.0 GPA, active member/leader of a school or community organization, and verifiable volunteer experience of at least 75 hours within the last calendar year. **See Ms. Elmore for an application.**

York County Education Association-Retired

Amount: \$500

This scholarship is sponsored by the York County Education Association-Retired. Criteria: Minimum 3.0 GPA, intended Education major and financial need. **See Ms. Elmore for an application.**

Hospitality Tourism Education Scholarship

Amount: \$2,000

This scholarship is sponsored by the York County Partners in Tourism. Criteria: High school senior in York County (SC) who has applied to a college with the intention to enroll in a hospitality and tourism-related program, minimum 2.5 GPA, and worked, volunteered or currently doing so in the hospitality or tourism industry. Brother David Memorial Scholarship

Amount: \$1,000

This scholarship is sponsored by the City of Rock Hill and the Piedmont Municipal Power Program (PMPA). Criteria: high school senior, plan to attend an accredited South Carolina college/university, minimum unweighted 3.0 GPA, must have community service and parent/guardian must have an active residential electric utility account with the city of Rock Hill. Powerful Minds Scholarship

Amount: \$1,000

Criteria: High school senior planned to attend an accredited South Carolina college/university in the fall, minimum unweighted 3.0 GPA and parents must have an active residential electric utility account with the City of Rock Hill. Jamie Nichols Alumni Scholarship Fund

Amount: \$1,200

This scholarship is sponsored by Mr. Jamie Nichols, who is a Northwestern High School alumni. Criteria: Financial need, minimum 2.9 GPA or top 50% of class, minimum 1000 SAT or 21 ACT and have a parent/guardian who has been incarcerated for longer than 12 months post-2005. This scholarship was not claimed last year. See Ms. Elmore for an application.

Rock Hill Scott-ites Scholarship

Amount: \$500

This scholarship is sponsored by the Rock Hill Scott-ites. The Rock Hill Scott-Ites are former students and teachers of Emmett Scott High School. Applicants must be current seniors at a high school in Rock Hill School District and have a minimum unweighted 3.0 GPA. See Ms. Elmore for an application.
