Dental Assistant - Research

- Assistants never work alone, they only work when the doctor is in the room.
- Dental Assistants make patients as comfortable as possible in the dental chair, prepare them for treatment, and obtain dental records. They pass instruments and materials to the dentist and maintain a clear working field by using suction or other devices. They sterilize and disinfect instruments and equipment, prepare trays setups for dental procedures, and instruct patients on postoperative and general oral health care. DA prepare materials for impressions and restorations as well as expose radiographs. They remove sutures and remove excess cement used in restorations.

Dental Hygienist-Research

- Dental hygienists are skilled healthcare workers who typically work in dentists' offices. They must be trained in techniques, skills and concepts of dental care and need to gain state licensure. Their job duties center around cleaning patients' teeth and giving instruction in proper dental hygiene. This may be a good career for those who enjoy working directly with people and have an interest in healthcare jobs.
- Their salary ranges from \$70,000-80,000 depending on the dental office.
