## WORK EXPERIENCE

Because I was unable to actually work on regular patients due to lawsuits, I was lucky enough to get to work on my sister's mouth and act as if she had a cavity. I became familiar with the tools used and how to properly use them. In this picture I was using the high vacuum suction tool to help keep her mouth dry. I was also able to get insight on the pros and cons of being a dental hygienist and the relationships you get to develop.



The average salary for a dental hygienist in Rock Hill, SC is 70,000\$, but the average salary obviously differs depending on what city you're working. Mary Beth shown in the right picture between Shyla and I has worked at Michele Boyne Pediatrics for 17 years and makes 83,000\$ not counting bonuses. Dental hygiene requires an associates degree but usually takes three years because of pre-reqs. Both of these women love their job.
