Located in Rock Hill, SC, Northwestern is a comprehensive public high school with a current enrollment of 1797 diverse students in grades 9 - 12. More than 200 courses are offered, including International Baccalaureate, Advanced Placement, Dual Credit, Honors, and College Preparatory. In the graduating class of 2017, 200 students enrolled in 4-year colleges or universities; 148 enrolled in 2-year colleges, 10 entered the armed services, and 52 entered the workforce.
