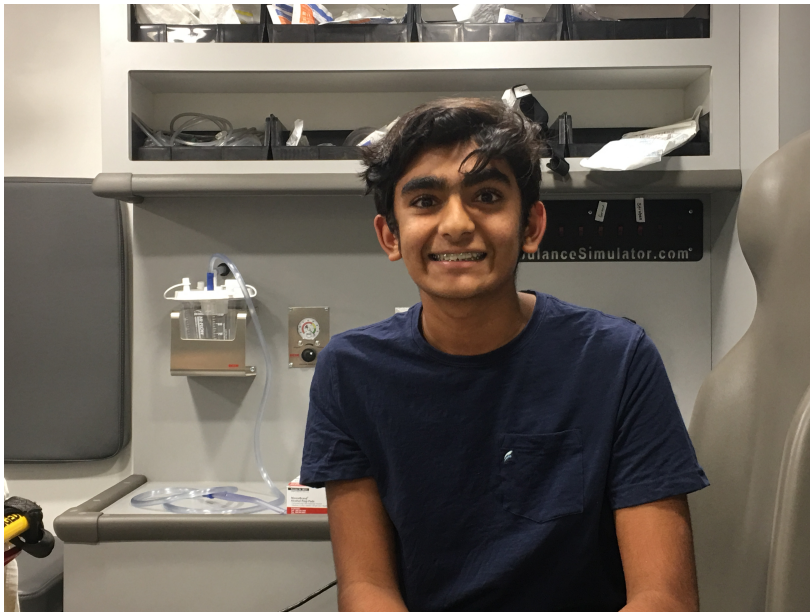
CLINICAL STUDIES George
