# STAR STUDENT FOR DRAFTING

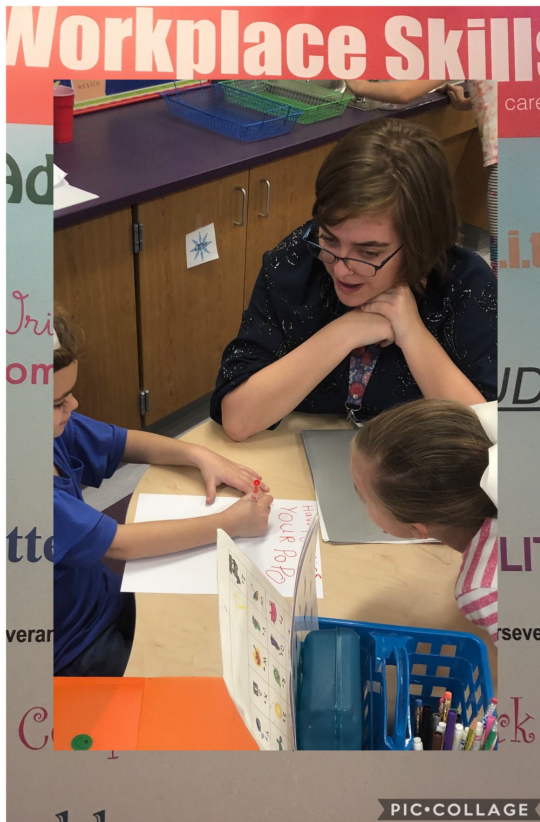

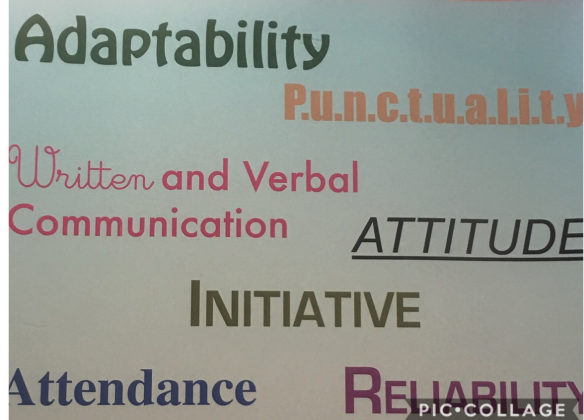
# STAR STUDENT FOR COSMETOLOGY

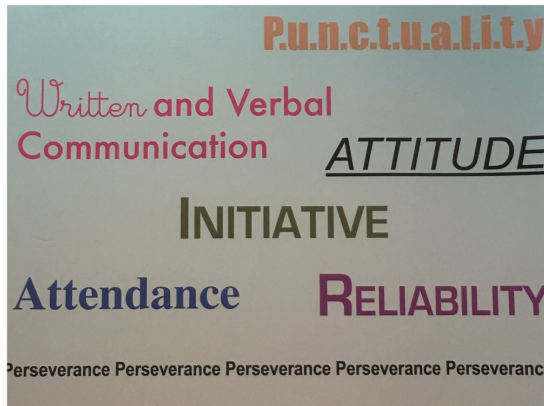

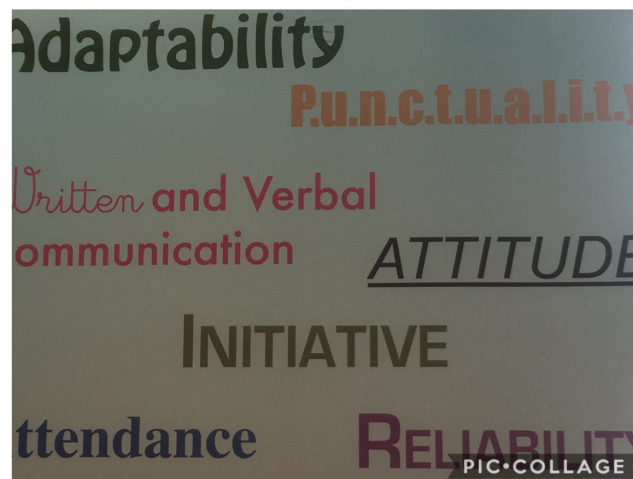


# WELDING

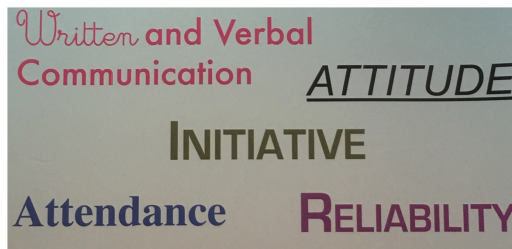


# CHINESE
