STAR STUDENT FOR COSMETOLOGY



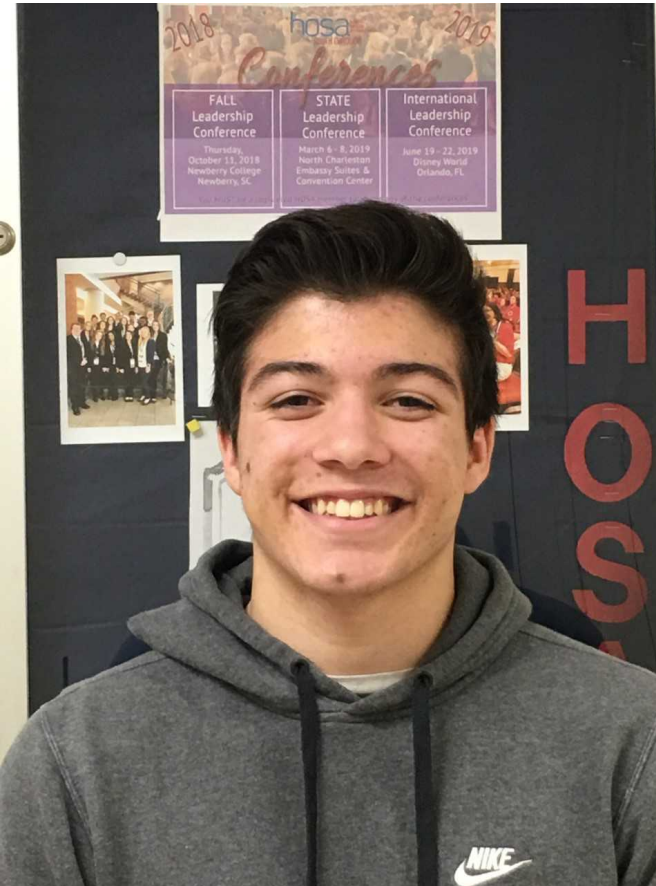
Alexis Johnston Norman is the Star Student for the Cosmetology program.

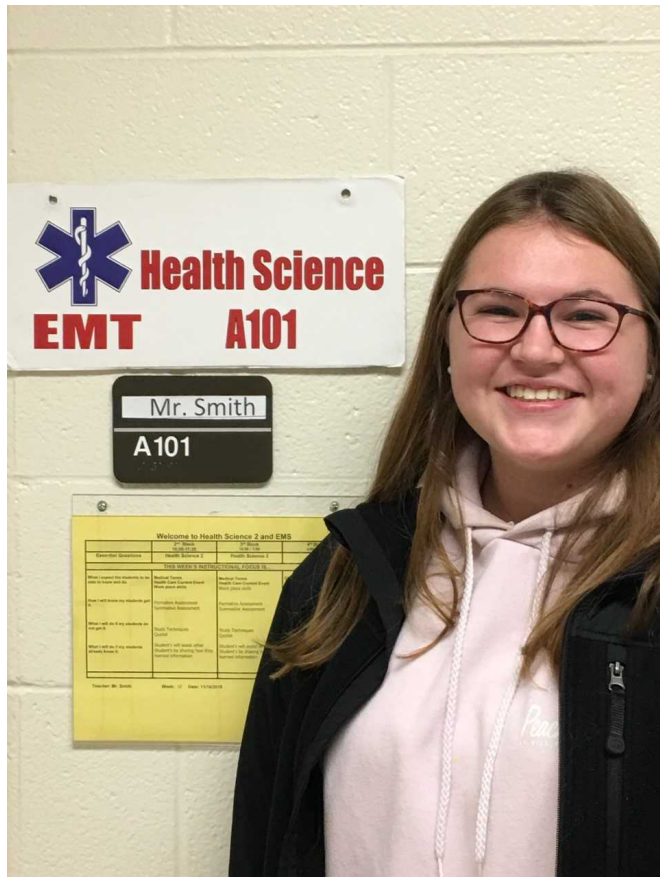
CLINICAL STUDIES
