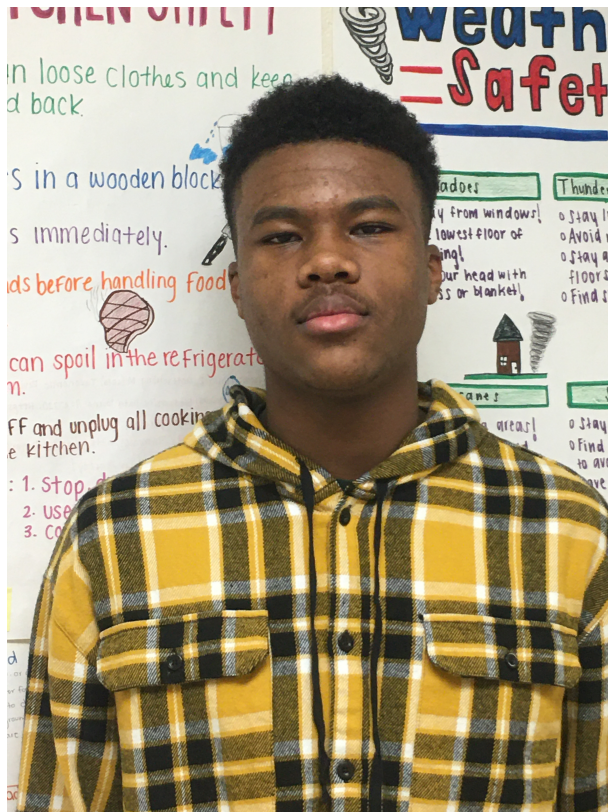

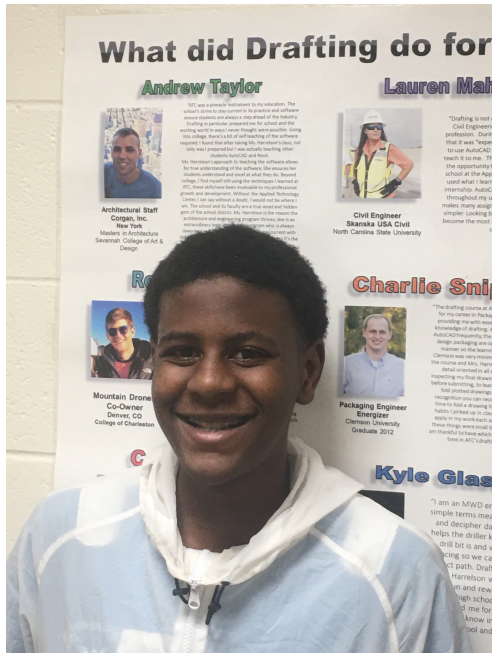


# Advanced Technology for Design and Production.
