Fundamentals of Computing



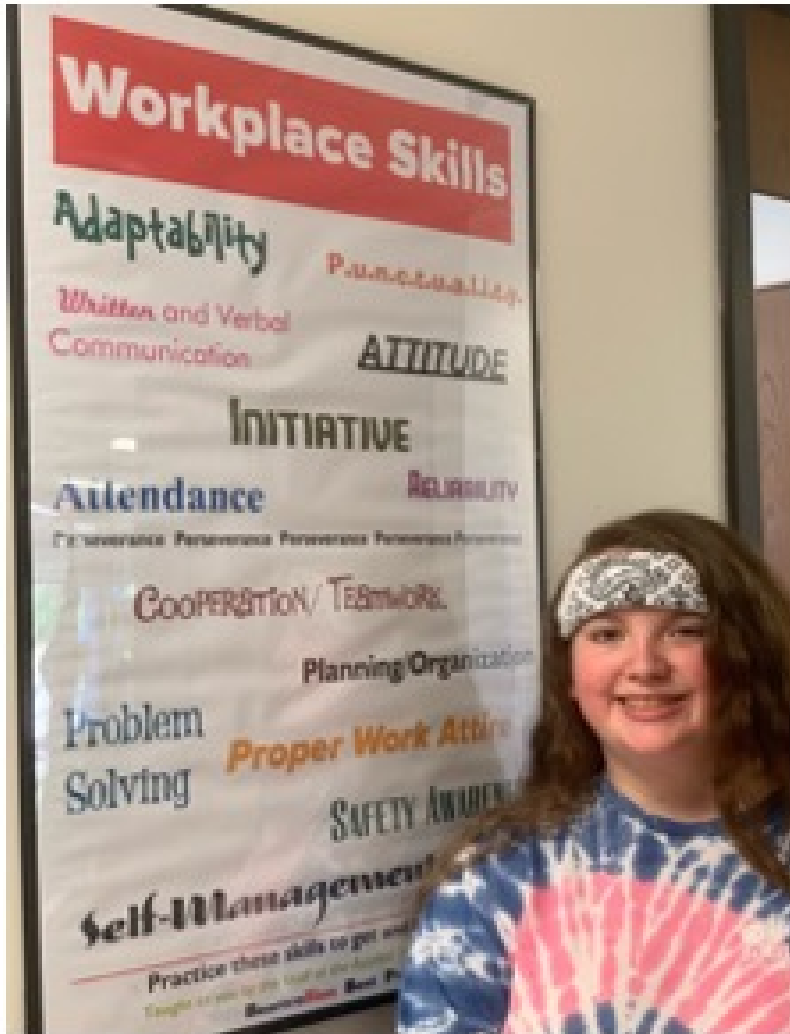
