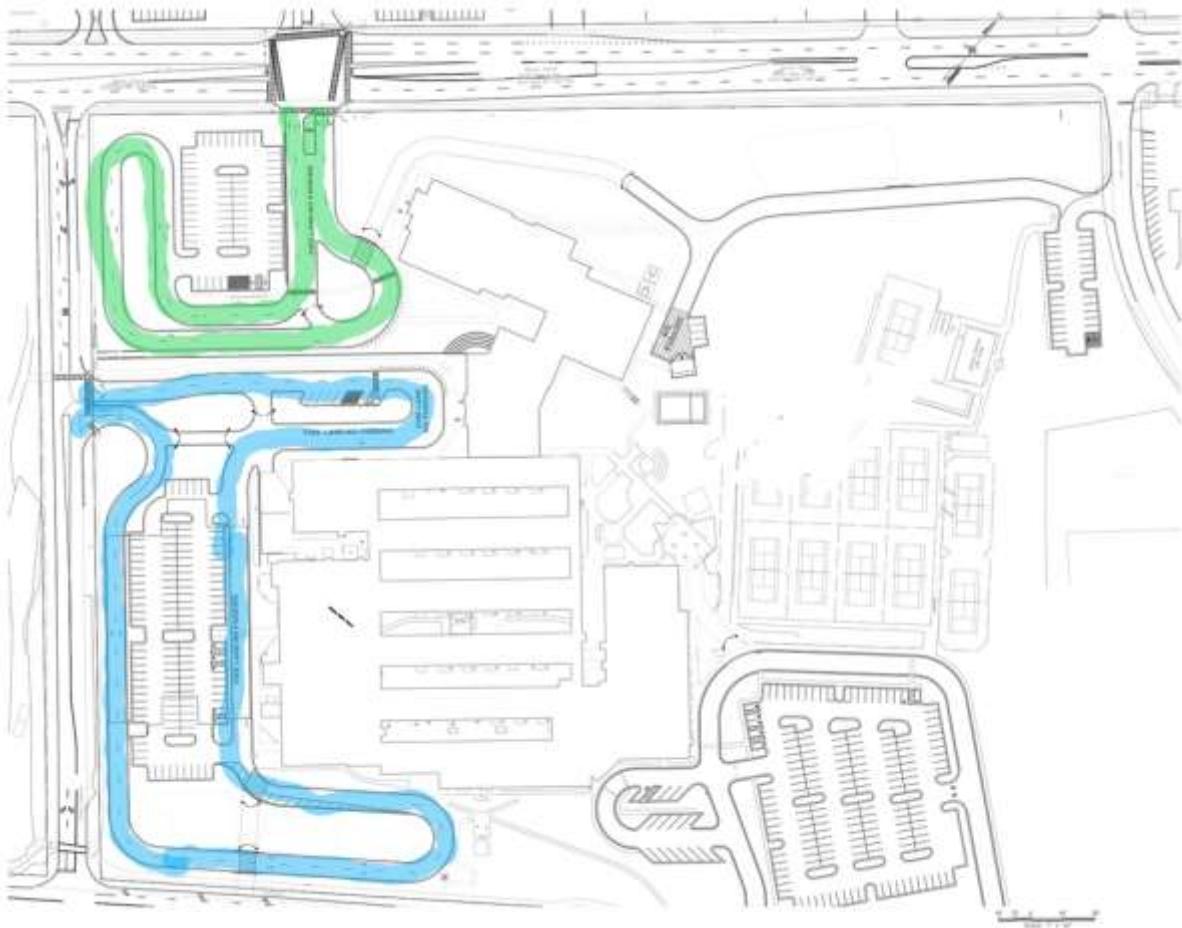

That is the big question about Cherry Park Elementary. Of course, you are asking which drive (Cherry Road or Caswell) you use to drop off your children and pick them up. My best answer to you is “Either one. You pick and tell us.” Here is what we are thinking. At the Cherry Road

Entrance, kindergarten and first grade kids will find it easy to get out of their cars and walk straight into the building closest to their downstairs classrooms. Traffic may back up some at the light, so we don't want to load up all our kids there. At the Caswell Entrance, second through fifth grade kids can get out and have an easy walk to their classroom areas. If you have kids at both grades (such as a first grader and a fifth grader), you can drop them off at either area and they will walk to their waiting spot. In the afternoon, we will get the kids to the pickup area (Cherry Road Entrance or Caswell Entrance) you tell us. You will let your child's teacher know at Open House on Wednesday, December 12 from 6:00-7:30 PM.

As I've thought about this question, it reminds me that we're always asking this question. Should I take this job or that one? Do we move to another house or stay where we are? Should I listen to this medical opinion or that one? We want to be sure. We don't like risks. We want to be right, not wrong. Sometimes, when we ask "which way do I go?" we have to acknowledge that we get stuck in the paralysis of analysis. We certainly want to do our homework and make informed decisions but there are also times when we are simply not going to know the answer and we need to make our best guess. Most of the time, I find that when I do that, I am relieved to finally make a decision. Even if it is the wrong one, it can be corrected most of the time. The world doesn't end and in a couple of weeks, I have completely forgotten about the situation. Which way do you need to go? I don't know but don't miss the blessing of the ride in getting there. (That really is true in choosing which entrance to use at Cherry Park Elementary. Treasure the time in your car with your kids. It doesn't last long. I promise.)
