

READ YOUR WAY AROUND THE WORLD!
CPES Summer Reading Challenge

JUST HOW FAR CAN YOU READ THIS SUMMER?

Imagine for every 1 minute you read you could travel 100 miles?

Then 15 minutes would = 1500 miles....WOW!

Each box on the map represents this.

ONE BOX on the map = **15** minutes and an imaginary **1500** miles on the map.

Lets do some math...

15 minutes = 1 ✓ed box - You make a ✓mark with pencil or pen.

42✓ed boxes = 630 minutes (42x15)

or a 63000 mile trip around the world (42x1500)

How far can you go?

- For every 15 minutes you read, put a check in one of the boxes on the path that travels across the world.
- Make sure your parents sign your map to verify your reading at the end of the summer.
- **Return the map with your first and last name as well as your 2025-2026 homeroom teacher by August 8, 2025**
- Any one returning a completed map will get a small treat.
- All completed entries will be entered into a drawing for a back to school prize pack containing books, school supplies and other goodies!
- Reading can be done alone, with a partner or with a parent.
- Reading of any genre can be counted.
- You can read more than 15 minutes at a time. Example - if a student reads for 45 minutes at one time, he or she can check three boxes at one time. (15 minutes = 1 check)
- If you run out of boxes, just add more checks anywhere on the page.
- **ONLY TURN IN YOUR MAP IF YOUR HAVE CHECKED ALL THE BOXES. ONLY COMPLETED MAPS WILL QUALIFY.**
