WHAT ARE WE LEARNING IN 4th GRADE?

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Reading- We are studying non-fiction. First, we are focusing on how to read non-fiction books. We are analyzing text features. We will also be learning about central idea and details, drawing conclusions, and inferring. We will be researching about weather too!

Writing- Our new unit is on Opinion Essays! We are learning how to do this grown-up writing by looking at the content and form of essays. We plan our essays using boxes and bullets to organize our thesis and reasons. Then, we will be drafting using our paragraph forms.

Math- Keep studying multiplication facts. We are learning strategies to solve multi-digit multiplication: repeated addition, partial products, array, area models, and the box method. We are learning how to be efficient, being accurate in a timely manner. We will move on to money after we finish multiplication.

Science- We are studying weather. We start by learning about the atmosphere and the water cycle. Then, we will move our focus to types of severe weather: thunderstorms, hurricanes, and tornados.

Social Studies- The English colonies are having conflict with the mother country. We are learning about the events that led to the Revolutionary War: French and Indian War, Stamp Act, Boston Massacre, Tea Act, Boston Tea Party, and the Intolerable Acts. We will also learn about the people: King George III, Patrick Henry, George Washington, Crispus Attucks, John Adams, and more!
