Pre-Kindergarten for Four-Year-Olds (4K)

Age Requirement. Students must be age 4 on or before September 1, 2017, to attend pre-kindergarten for four-year-olds.

Half-Day Programs

A half-day program is available at Central Child Development Center (morning or afternoon); parents may apply at Central Child Development Center, the Applied Technology Center or at the District Office. Students will be screened at the end of the current school year; parents will be notified by early July if their child has been accepted or placed on a waiting list.

Title I Full-Day Programs (Possibly available in schools listed in bold below) If you and your child reside in the following attendance zone, **Bellevue, Ebenezer Avenue, Finley Road, Oakdale, Rosewood or York Road Elementary School**, you may apply at the respective school or at the District Office. Applications are due by **May 22, 2017**. There is limited space available for this full day program. Students will be screened at the end of the current school year and parents will be notified by early July if their child has been accepted. Once the program is full, applications will be forwarded to the Central Child Development Center to be processed for its half-day program.

Kindergarten for Five-Year-Olds (5K)

Children must be age 5 on or by Sept. 1, 2017. Kindergarten for five-year-olds is a full-day program. Applications will be available in all elementary schools.

First Grade

Children must be age 6 on or by September 1, 2017. Students will attend a full day. Parents can register their child at the elementary school in their attendance zone or at the district office any school day between 8:00-3:00. A listing of schools is provided on the back of this brochure.

Tuition Based Programs

Full-day, tuition-based 4K programs are offered at The Children's School at Sylvia Circle and Old Pointe Elementary. Parents who are interested should inquire at the school.

What is Needed to Enroll:

- **your child's legal birth certificate**
- **a current S.C. Certificate of Immunization**
- **child's legal guardian's current proof of residence**
(this document can be: a gas bill, an electric bill or a lease agreement)

Challenger After-School Program

Each elementary school offers an after-school program. The cost associated with the after-school program is based on your child's lunch status. Challenger Registration Forms are available at the RHSD office, your child's elementary school as well as online. Please check with your school or the Challenger office for the application deadline.
