

Summer Contest for Rising 6th Graders: Displaying the Weather



Task

Locate in the newspaper, in a magazine, or online, a weather chart and a weather graph. Write an analysis of each in a paragraph. Indicate the source of the chart and graph beneath each.

Specifics

- Displays may be no larger than 8½ x 11 inches, in portrait orientation.
- Each display must contain 1 chart and 1 graph (line, pie, or bar).
- The chart, graph, and 2 paragraphs must all be on the same side of the paper.
- Analysis of the chart / graph should include a summary of what is shown, any trends, future implications, and questions that arise based on the data.
- Displays should be attractive and use color.
- The more unique the chart or graph, the better!
- On the back of the display should be the student's name (no nicknames, please), school, grade-level to begin fall 2017 (should be 7th grade), a contact phone number (may be a parent's), and a contact email address (may be a parent's).

Submission

ALL displays are due by Thursday, June 29, 2017. Displays may be dropped off at the front desk of ANY middle school in Rock Hill School District 3. Remember, buildings are closed on Fridays. Participants must be students of Rock Hill School District. Winners will be announced at the start of the 2017-18 school year.
