

Science Contest for Rising 8th Graders



Task

Make a flyer that addresses one of the following questions:

- **Why is it especially dangerous to look at the sun during a solar eclipse?**
- **How can we predict when an eclipse will occur?**
- **What's the difference between a solar eclipse and a lunar eclipse?**

Specifics

- Flyers may be no larger than 8½ x 11in, but may be either landscape or portrait.
- Flyers must contain both words and pictures—explanations, captions, etc.
- Your question should appear in the heading and the flyers must answer the question.
- Flyers should be attractive and use color.
- On the back of the flyer, a list of websites or book titles used for information must be listed.
- On the back of the flyer should be the student's name (no nicknames, please), school, grade-level to begin fall 2017 (should be 8th grade), a contact phone number (may be a parent's), a contact email address (may be a parent's).

Submission

ALL flyers are due by Thursday, June 29, 2017. Flyers may be dropped off at the front desk of ANY middle school in Rock Hill School District 3. Remember, schools are closed on Fridays. Participants must be students of Rock Hill School District. Winners will be announced at the start of the 2017-18 school year.
