Our enrollment numbers this year have been steady, and we anticipate an increase in student enrollment in the 2020-2021 school year.

Sunset Park has earned six South Carolina Palmetto Gold and Silver Awards for the academic performance of its students! We had five students earn perfect scores on the SCPASS and SCREADY test this year. Our students continue to make us so proud!

Our school staff has collaborated this year on many school-wide goals. Planning sessions are led by our G/T teacher-coach, our Literacy Specialist, Math Coach, and District Math and Literacy Coaches. We are also in partnership with the College of Education at Winthrop University.
