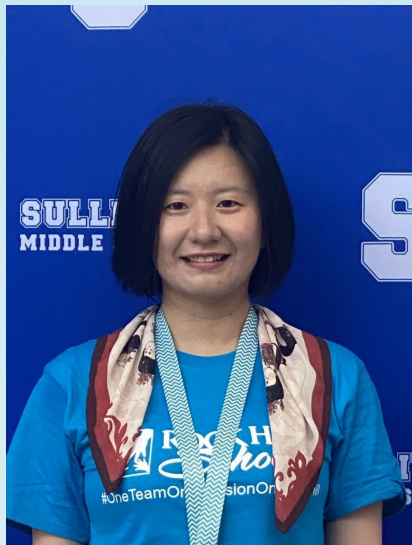

# **What are Teams?**

- ➔ At Sullivan Middle School, students will be assigned to a core team. The team is traditionally comprised of four content specific teachers.
- ➔ Teams travel together on field experiences and celebrate team days.
- ➔ Teams are great for parents because the parent can contact one teacher and get information to, or from, his or her child's content teachers.

# The Transition

## Elementary

- 1 teacher and an assistant provide PE (scheduled recess)
- Indoor Lunch (Cafeteria)
- District Approved Code of Dress
- Up to fifty percent of core classes taught in a foreign/immersion language

## Middle

- 4 teachers/coaches on staff to provide PE and Health instruction (all physical activity provided in PE or during team/grade level activities)
- Indoor/Outdoor Lunch (Cafeteria/Canteen-weather permitting)
- Standard Code of Dress
- All students experience foreign language during electives.
- Immersion students are provided additional instruction in the targeted language during Social Studies.

# Special Services

*All students in the Rock Hill Schools are provided equal educational opportunities.*

Students who are serviced as ESOL, ESE, or GT as designated by the elementary school will receive those services in 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

These classifications must have been identified in the elementary as designated by state standards.

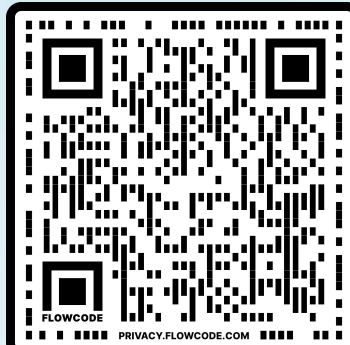
