#### **FACT SHEET**

Rock Hill Schools held its 2018 Teacher Recruitment Fair on Saturday, February 24th, with approximately 200 pre-registered and walk-ins attending the fair. Participants were from Arkansas, Washington, D.C., Florida, Georgia, Virginia and parts of North Carolina and South Carolina.



South Pointe Beta Club Students and ROTC students were assigned to assist at registration tables. Students also served as "runners" throughout the fair.

Approximately 100 Assistant Principals and teachers were involved in pre-screening applicants while school administrator's networked with applicants at their school's table.

Chef Tyrone Jenkins and members of his Culinary Arts class (ATC) prepared and served delicious refreshments, ensuring that staff members were "well taken care of" throughout the

Soft drinks and water (donated by Coca Cola) were available for candidates in the school cafeteria as they waited for their prescreening and/or school interviews.

#### Of those candidates who indicated their certification area, we hosted candidates in the following areas:

Special Education, School Counseling, Social Studies, Music Education, Math, Science, Middle Level Math & Science, Middle Level English & Social Studies, Instrumental Music, Elementary Education Early Childhood, Modern Languages/French, Media Specialist, Family & Consumer Science, Physical Education and Health.
