

SUBJECT: Proposed Comporium Cellular Tower at Mount Gallant Elementary School –

**Project Update**

At its October 2017 Business Meeting the Board of Trustees approved a lease agreement with Comporium for the construction and operation of a cellular telecommunications tower at Mount Gallant Elementary School. Comporium's original intent shared with the Board was to procure all necessary project approvals from federal and local agencies and construct the tower and base equipment over the summer of 2018.

An update provided today by Comporium:

- 1. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has approved the tower at a lower height of 146′ (142′ with 4′ lightning rod). The airport objected to the 172′ height due to their new proposed runway. AT&T, Comporium's prime customer for the use of the tower, is aware of the lower height and Comporium is moving forward with the project.
- 2. McCutchen Engineering, under contract to Comporium is working on the City of Rock Hill zoning submittal, to be filed tomorrow for a scheduled June 19<sup>th</sup> zoning public hearing.
- 3. Given these dates and the subsequent Federal Communications Commission (FCC) approval still required, it will not be possible to construct the tower during the summer.

We have informed the school principal and have let Comporium know we will work with them on setting an alternate construction start date. At all times we will ensure that their onsite activities do not interfere in any way with our school campus operations or affect school safety and security.
