Rock Hill Schools expends over \$30 million each year in procurement and purchasing of goods and services to support the mission of the district. This volume of purchasing is executed through more than 35,000 individual contracting actions annually, and is governed by the Rock Hill Schools Consolidated Procurement Code and the associated Purchasing Procedures Manual, both adopted July 1, 2008.

As allowed under the Code and South Carolina Law and regulations, only actions over \$10,000 value must be formally procured, with appropriate advertisement, competition, and bid or proposal procedures. All procedures include active communication and evaluation steps prior to award of a contract. There are also procedures for fairly and equitably resolving disputes between parties in the procurement (pre-award) and administration (post-award) phases of a contract.

The exact procedures used depends on what good or service, and from which source we need to buy. Details on this process can be found at our Purchasing Department website: http://www.rock-hill.k12.sc.us/Domain/297 or by clicking "Departments" and "Purchasing" from the Rock Hill Schools Website.

It is our intent to keep the Board informed of key contract actions. In general, information on all formalized procurements may be found at the Purchasing Department's webpage under the heading "Bids and RFPs".

In addition, the Construction Management Office provides the Board a quarterly update on all major projects and activity of our "Build On The Rock" program to implement referendum-and 8%-based capital outlay programs.

To further inform the Board of ongoing actions, this procurement update will be provided on a monthly basis. Today please find attached the report of awards made during the past month.

Upcoming contracts and construction projects are listed on the webpage, and are included with the Build On The Rock updates

Finally, the Board will be informed as soon as practical on any significant and specific developments in projects, services and equipment contracts through appropriate public ("Hotline") or confidential means.
